<p>Cllr Liz Frost, Woodcote Ward, Epsom & Ewell Borough Council</p>	<p>At the previous meeting at Epsom, I asked that:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That those of us attending the meeting could have Wi-Fi access rather than having to download all the papers onto a tablet or similar to bring with us. I understood that this would be the case and that it would be publicised in the invitation to discourage people from printing off reams of pages. • Invitations of these meetings include a link to the papers on the website. This has no such link, and unless you know exactly what to search for, it is not easy to find. <p>My memory of the meeting is that these two requests were agreed – however this message contains no link to the relevant page on the website, nor information about whether we will be given Wi-Fi access.</p> <p>Currently the only paper that appears on the website is the agenda. It states that other papers are attached, but they do not appear to have yet been uploaded, but I assume they will be gradually added over the next few days.
