Following biopsy of your cervix

Following your biopsy procedure you may get some vaginal discharge for a few days – this is quite normal. This may be fresh blood at first followed by a brownish discharge. If you get any fresh bleeding after the initial day or two and your period is not due, then go and see your GP. Please do not worry, as this could just mean that there is an infection which is easily cleared up with a course of antibiotics.

It is very important to only use sanitary pads and **not** tampons whilst you have the discharge. This is to give the cervix time to heal.

Do **not** have sexual intercourse until the discharge has stopped.
